The Booster Cookout will be on August 6 after the parent meeting.


- School begins for freshmen on **Thursday, August 8th** from 7:50 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. (School dress code should be followed.)
- **Tuesday, August 6th** Parent Information Night – Gr. 9, 10, 11, 12 – 6:00 p.m. in gym
Joseph Beth Booksellers will be in the gym lobby for your convenience with books that will be required reading for English classes during the 2019-20 school year. Make sure you check your son's English class level to order books. Flyer/order form is enclosed.

- **DROP OFF AND PARKING LOT** – The drop-off procedure and parking is to be determined. Information about parking will be sent out at a later date via email as soon as the lots are ready.

- **Friday, August 23rd – Mass @ St. Agnes**
Parents are welcome to attend any of our all-school liturgies throughout the year. Our first all-school Mass is Friday, August 23rd at 10:00 a.m. (St. Agnes), and our celebrant will be Most Reverend Roger J. Foys, Bishop of Covington. We also have rosary services every Tuesday and Thursday at 7:30 a.m. and Mass every Friday at 7:10 a.m. in our school chapel.
- **Wednesday, September 4th** - Parent Mini-Schedule Night
- The lunch price for all high schools in the Diocese of Covington will be at \$3.15 per lunch which includes a drink. Reduced lunch price remains at \$0.40. A full lunch comes with milk. Fruit juice or flavored/plain water is an additional charge of \$1.00 per bottle. Optional deli sandwiches and lunch salads are available daily.
- The participation fee for athletics is \$150.00 per year (not per sport) for the first athlete and \$100.00 for any additional athlete(s) in your family. As rosters are finalized for each sport, the fee will be billed through your FACTS account during the first sports season in which the student-athlete participates. For athletes who participate in fall sports, the fee will be due on August 31st; for winter sports, the fee will be due on November 30th; and for spring sports, the fee will be due on March 30th

I look forward to beginning the school year and to fostering an environment that encourages each young man to work to his potential spiritually, academically, physically, and socially.
