Covington Catholic, a 2016 National Blue Ribbon School, is proud to announce that senior Aidan Donaghy has been recognized by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation as a Finalist, making him 1 of only 15,000 students nationwide to receive this designation.

Aidan is the president of the National Honor Society (NHS) and captain of the Quiz Team. He is a four-year member of the Governor's Cup Team and a member of the National English Honor Society (NEHS), was selected for the NaviGo Legal Scholars group, won 1st Place in the Kentucky Secretary of the State's Essay Contest, and participates in several other CCH clubs.
